3. The budget for Fairfax County Public Schools is larger than the general fund of 5 states. Does the candidate have any experience in dealing with large budgets and how do you believe he or she would go about setting budget priorities?
4. Is there something specific you believe the candidate would like to achieve if elected?
5. How do you believe the candidate would plan on staying connected with students, parents, teachers, and the community at large?
6. In your opinion of the candidate's approach, what steps should the School Board take to assure that FCPS graduates are best prepared to enter the 21st century workplace?
7. If the candidate is not selected for the FCDC endorsement, will he or she commit to refrain from filing as a candidate and to publicly support the FCDC endorsed candidates?

Responses to the questions from the FCDC At-Large Endorsement Questionnaire are optional. Their inclusion in your response is recommended but not required.
